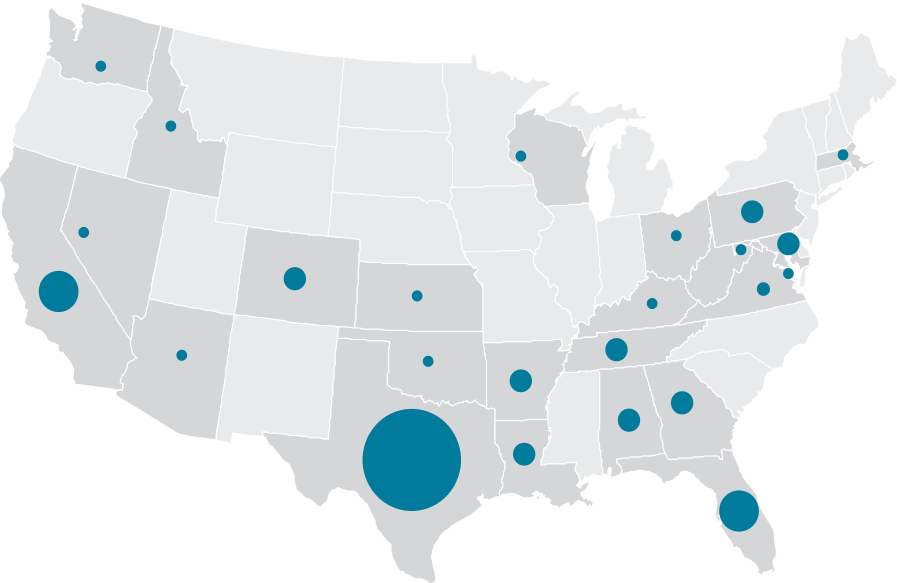

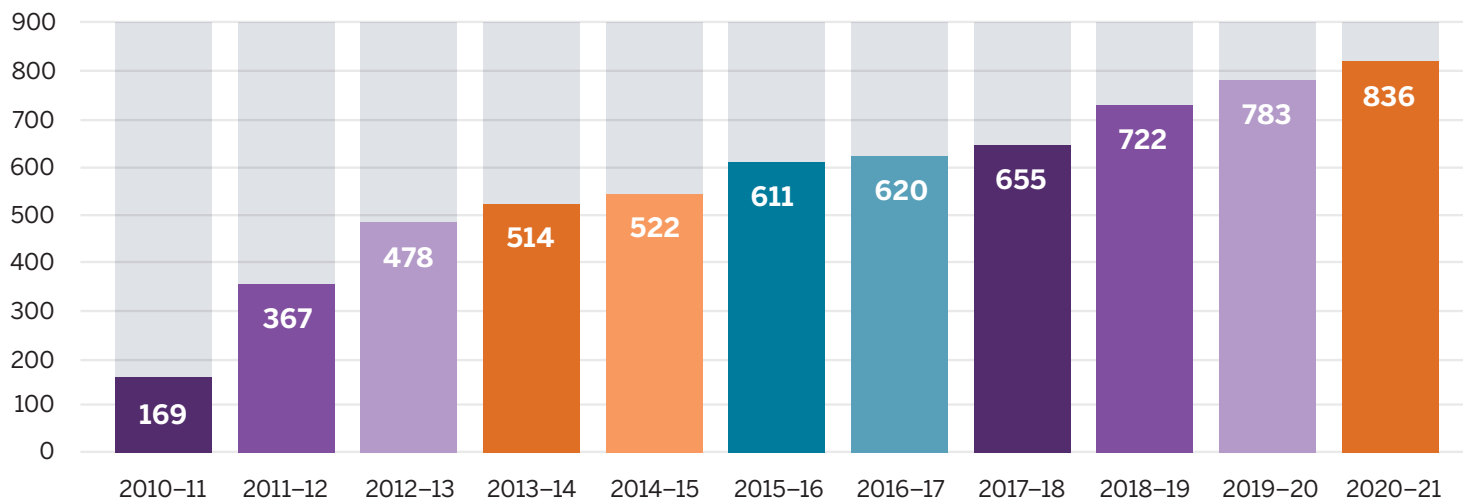


UTeach graduates are projected to teach more than 900,000 STEM students annually by 2026.
