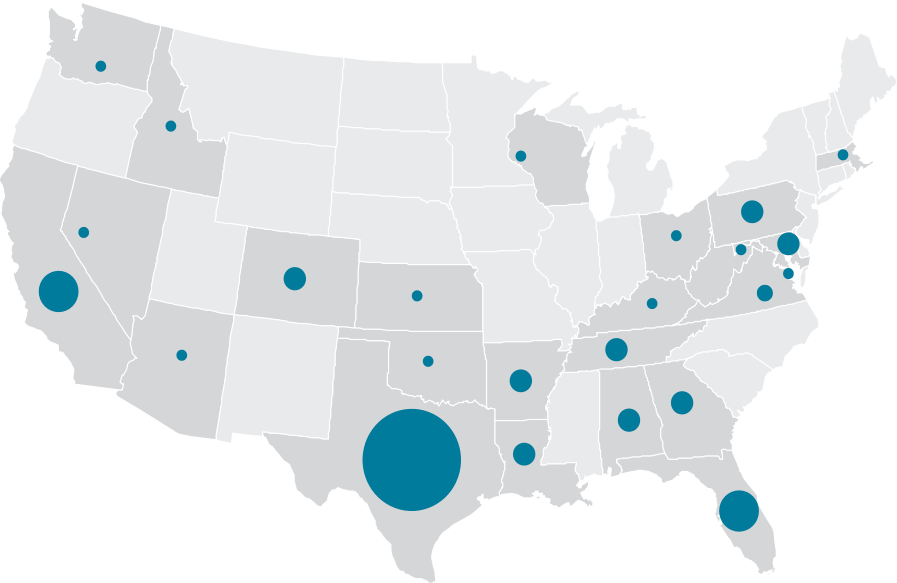

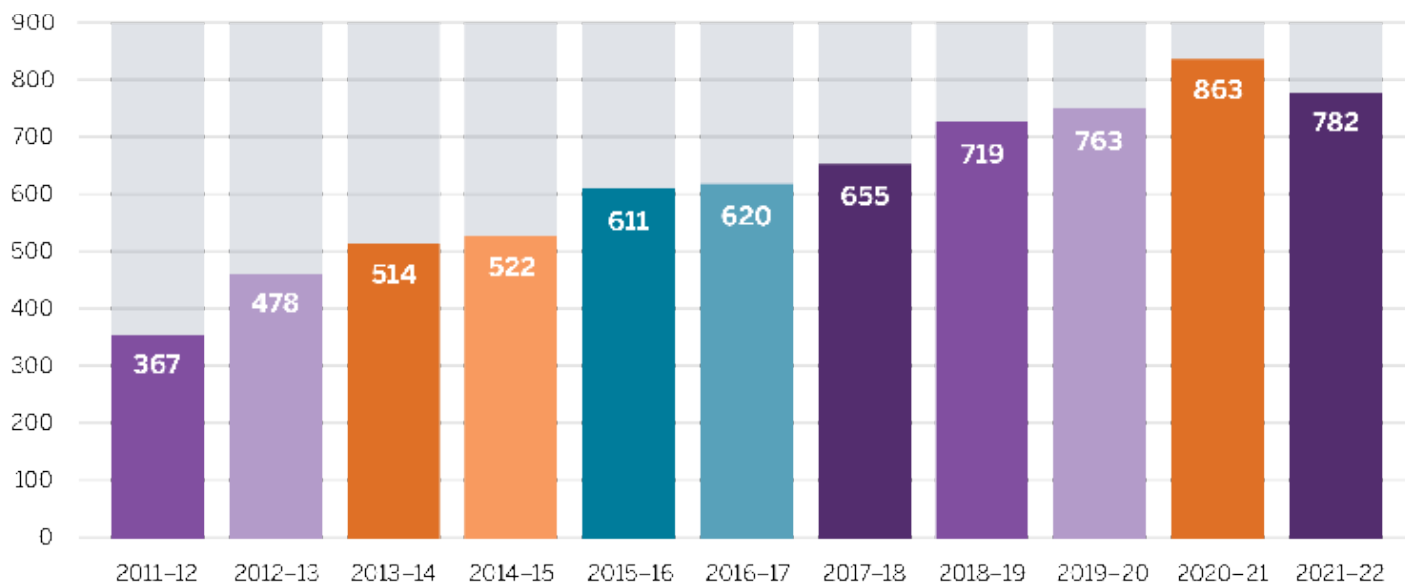


UTeach graduates are projected to teach more than 1,000,000 STEM students annually by 2027.
