

UTeach Expansion in Texas SPRING 2021

UTeach is a national network of colleges and universities working together to improve STEM teaching and learning in the U.S. The UTeach network crosses the entire nation, with UTeach teacher preparation programs in 49 universities and thousands of UTeach alumni working at school, district, and state levels.

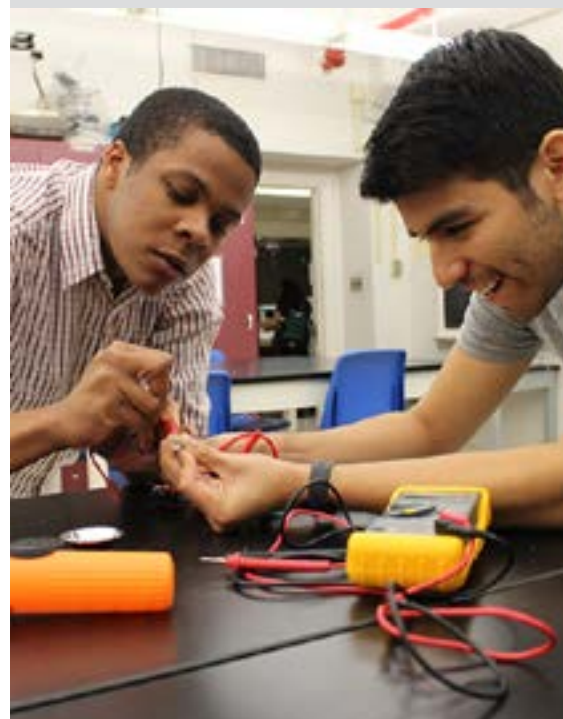
UTeach programs produce passionate, well-prepared teachers who stay in teaching longer and improve student performance in math and science.

Eleven Texas universities have UTeach programs, including the original UTeach program started in 1997 at the University of Texas at Austin.



UTeach graduates in Texas are projected to teach more than 400,000 STEM students annually by 2026.

The UTeach Institute supports a national community that improves STEM education by increasing the number and diversity of high-quality teachers and improving access to inquiry-based curriculum.

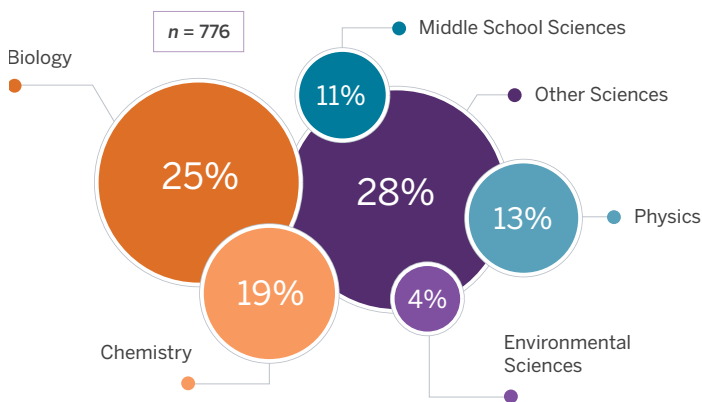

Employment records were obtained for 92% (2,348) of program graduates through Spring 2019. Graduates from 2019-2020 are excluded from this data.

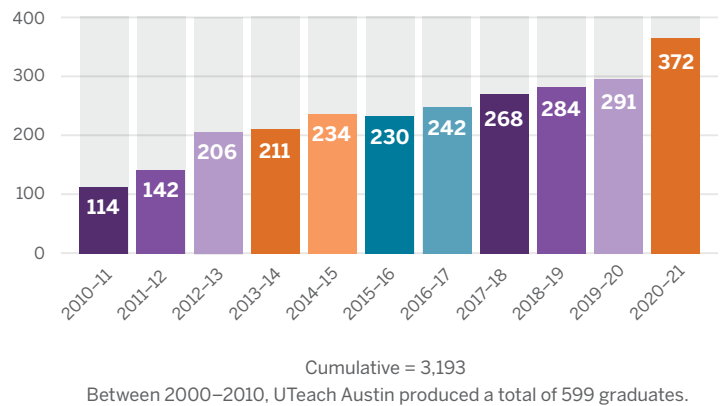
SCIENCE COURSES TAUGHT BY TEXAS UTEACH GRADUATES

2020 - 2021



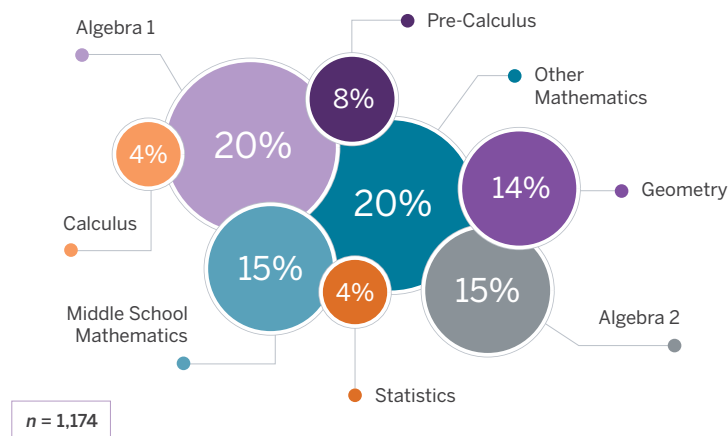
ANNUAL TEXAS UTEACH GRADUATE PRODUCTION
