
UTeach is a national network of colleges and universities working together to improve STEM teaching and learning in the U.S. The UTeach network crosses the entire nation, with UTeach teacher preparation programs in 53 universities and thousands of UTeach alumni working at school, district, and state levels.

UTeach programs produce well-prepared teachers who stay in teaching longer and improve student performance in math and science.


