In 2021, we held the first Equity and Racial Justice in STEM Teacher Development Summit online. This year's summit will be in-person and held the day before the UTeach STEM Educators Conference.

### What is UTeach?

*UTeach is a nationally recognized program that prepares STEM majors to become teachers. More than 7,000 UTeach alumni across the nation are ready to teach STEM with attention to equity and racial diversity.*
